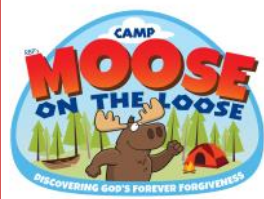
L.I.F.E. Group (Living In Faith Everyday)
