Please bring a salad, dessert, cut fruit or veggies to share with others for the lunch if you are able. We will provide cold drinks for everyone.

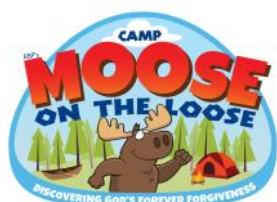
If you wish to eat outside, bring lawn chairs or a blanket (folding chairs from the Hall will be available also).
